Explanation of Symbols



The symbols "CE" are an abbreviation of the French term "Communate Europene," meaning the European Community. The European Community later evolved into the European Union (EU). In recent years, the CE marking has become increasingly prevalent on products sold in the European Economic Area (EEA), which includes member states of the European Union and the European Free Trade Association, excluding Switzerland. Products bearing the CE mark indicate compliance with a series of European directives related to safety, hygiene, environmental protection, and consumer protection



UKCA Certification (UKConformity Assessed) is a specific product mark in the UK, applicable to goods placed on the market in England, Wales, and Scotland. With Brexit, the UKCA mark has replaced the EU CE certification mark and become an important symbol in the UK market to prove that products comply with relevant UK regulations.

Operation

Step 1: Connect the power adapter to the product and plug into a suitable outlet.

Step 2: Press the power button to turn on the device.

Step 3: Use the control panel/buttons/remote to adjust settings as needed.

Step 4: Follow the display indicators for operational status.
