

The correct use of a mobile phone charger can extend the lifespan of the charger and the phone battery, and at the same time avoid safety hazards such as short circuits, overheating, and electric shock. The core principle is to match the equipment, follow the operation procedures, and stay away from potential hazard environments.

1. Before use: Check that the accessories are undamaged and the charging port is free of foreign objects;
2. Connection: Connect the power socket first, then the phone;
3. Charging: Avoid damp and high-temperature conditions, do not charge while under heavy load, and avoid covering or squeezing;
4. Insertion and removal: Remove the phone end first, then cut off the power supply, and do not leave it charging without load;
5. Storage: Wrap the cable naturally and store it in a dry and cool place;

Warning: If you hear abnormal sounds, feel the device getting hot, or smell a burnt smell, immediately cut off the power and stop using it.

Wireless charging additional instructions: Turn on the power first, then place the phone, and do not place any metal objects in between.
