

SmartPhone User Manual

1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing smartphone! This manual provides detailed instructions on how to use your device safely and effectively. Please read it carefully before use to fully explore all functions and avoid potential risks.

2. Package Contents

- 1 × Smartphone
- 1 × USB Cable
- 1 × Charger
- 1 × Protective Case

3. Getting Started

3.1 Inserting SIM Card

1. Power off the phone completely.
2. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the device (marked with a SIM icon).
3. Use the provided SIM card ejector pin to gently press the hole on the tray until it pops out.
4. Place your nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down, aligning with the slot shape.
5. Push the tray back into the phone firmly but gently.

3.2 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the side power button for 3 seconds until the TechLife logo appears.
-

Power Off: Press and hold the side power button, then tap "Power Off" on the screen. Confirm to shut down.

- **Restart:** Press and hold the side power button, then tap "Restart" to reboot the device.

3.3 Initial Setup

1. After powering on, select your preferred language, region, and time zone.
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network (enter the password if required) for system updates and app downloads.
3. Sign in with your Google account (or create a new one) to access Google services (Gmail, Play Store, etc.).
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to set up fingerprint/face recognition, screen lock password, and other security settings.

4. Basic Functions

4.1 Touch Screen Operations

- **Tap:** Lightly touch the screen with your finger to select an icon, open an app, or enter text.
- **Swipe:** Slide your finger left/right/up/down on the screen to switch pages, scroll through content , or open the notification panel.
- **Pinch:** Pinch two fingers together or spread them apart on the screen to zoom in/out of photos, web pages, or maps.
- **Long Press:** Press and hold an icon or text for 2 seconds to move apps, copy text, or access additional options.

4.2 Home Screen & App Drawer

- **Home Screen:** The main interface after unlocking. Swipe left/right to switch between home screen pages.
- **App Drawer:** Tap the "Apps" icon at the bottom center of the home screen to view all installed apps.
- **Add Widgets:** Long press an empty area on the home screen, select "Widgets", then drag your desired widget to the screen.

4.3 Making Calls & Sending Messages

- **Make a Call:** Open the "Phone" app, enter the phone number or select a contact from the address book, then tap the call icon.
- **Answer/End a Call:** Tap the green answer icon to answer a call, or the red end icon to hang up.
- **Send a Message:** Open the "Messages" app, tap the "+" icon to create a new message, select a contact, enter your text, and tap the send icon.

5. Advanced Features

5.1 Camera

- Open the "Camera" app by tapping the camera icon on the home screen or app drawer.
- Switch between photo, video, portrait, panorama, and other modes by swiping left/right on the mode bar.
- Adjust zoom by pinching the screen or using the zoom slider.
- Tap the screen to focus on a specific object; use the flash icon to turn on/off the flash.
- Save photos/videos to the gallery automatically after capture.

5.2 Battery Management

- **Check Battery Level:** The battery icon at the top right of the screen shows the remaining power.
- **Charge the Phone:** Connect the USB-C cable to the phone and a charger adapter (or computer). The charging icon will appear when charging is in progress.
- **Power Saving Mode:** Go to "Settings" > "Battery" > "Power Saving Mode" to enable it. This mode reduces screen brightness, limits background app activity, and extends battery life.

5.3 Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to "Settings" > "Wi-Fi", turn on Wi-Fi, select a available network, and enter the password to connect.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to "Settings" > "Bluetooth", turn on Bluetooth, select a device to pair with (ensure the other device is in pairing mode), and follow the prompts to complete pairing.

- **Mobile Data:** Go to "Settings" > "Mobile Network", turn on mobile data to access the internet when not connected to Wi-Fi.

6. Safety & Maintenance

6.1 Safety Precautions

- Do not expose the phone to extreme temperatures (below -10°C/14°F or above 45°C/113°F).
- Avoid contact with water, moisture, or liquids. The device is not waterproof unless specified.
- Do not disassemble, modify, or repair the phone by yourself; contact authorized service centers for maintenance.
- Use only original or certified chargers and cables to avoid battery damage or safety hazards.
- Keep the phone away from magnetic fields, sharp objects, and corrosive substances.

6.2 Maintenance Tips

- Clean the screen and body with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh cleaners or abrasive materials.
- Keep the charging port and headphone jack free of dust and debris.
- Update the system regularly: Go to "Settings" > "System" > "Software Update" to check for and install the latest updates.
- Avoid overcharging the battery (unplug the charger once fully charged).

7. Troubleshooting

| Problem | Solution |

| Phone won't power on | 1. Check if the battery is exhausted; charge for at least 30 minutes. 2. Press and hold the power button for 10 seconds to force restart. |
| Can't connect to Wi-Fi | 1. Check if the Wi-Fi password is correct. 2. Restart the router and the phone. 3. Forget the network and reconnect. |

| Touch screen not responding | 1. Clean the screen. 2. Restart the phone. 3. If the problem persists, contact customer service. |
| Battery drains too fast | 1. Close unused background apps. 2. Reduce screen brightness. 3. Disable unnecessary features (Bluetooth, location services). 4. Check for battery-draining apps in "Settings" > "Battery". |
